DAY 01

Mexico City Arrival

Assistance provided at your arrival to Mexico City Airport and private transfer to Mexico City Hotel.

Accommodation at Royal Reforma 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 02

Mexico City → Exploring the Cultural Heart of Mexico City.

Breakfast at Hotel. Immerse yourself in the historical and artistic richness of Mexico City with a tour designed for those seeking an authentic and sophisticated experience. This journey will take you through the most iconic cultural landmarks, from the majestic Historic Center — declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site — to the spaces where tradition and modernity converge. Discover colonial architecture, Diego Rivera's murals, and the secrets held within its museums and squares. Guided by expert hosts, you will enjoy a day that blends history, art, and gastronomy, revealing the essence of one of the most vibrant cities in the world. Included: Private transportation, English Speaking guide, Mexico City Historical Center (Palacio de Bellas Artes, The Zocalo, Metropolitan Cathedral, Templo mayor), entrance fee to Museo Mural Diego Rivera, 2 bottles of water during the tour. Accommodation at Royal Reforma 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 03

Mexico City → Historic Route Puebla - Cholula: A Journey to the Heart of Mexico

Discover the cultural, historical, and architectural richness that distinguishes two of Mexico's most iconic destinations: Puebla and Cholula. This comprehensive tour will take you through colonial landscapes, ancient archaeological sites, and world-renowned gastronomy, offering a unique and enriching experience. The journey begins with a visit to Cholula, home to the largest pyramid in the world by base and a remarkable example of cultural fusion. Here, you will admire the Temple of Our Lady of the Remedies, built atop the Great Pyramid, from where you can enjoy spectacular views of the Popocatepetl and Iztaccíhuatl volcanoes. We will then continue to the city of Puebla, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its pristine Baroque architecture, picturesque streets, and majestic temples create a fascinating atmosphere. We will visit iconic landmarks such as Puebla Cathedral, the Rosary Chapel—considered a jewel of New Spanish Baroque—and the traditional Historic Center, where you can explore artisan markets and admire the famous Talavera pottery from Puebla. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 3 Course Lunch in a Local Restaurant (drinks during lunch are not included), visit to Cholula and Puebla, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Royal Reforma 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 04

Mexico City → Sacred Route: Exploring Teotihuacán and the Basilica of Guadalupe.

Breakfast at Hotel. Discover the spiritual and historical grandeur of Mexico on a unique journey that brings together two of its most iconic sites. Begin your experience by visiting the impressive archaeological zone of Teotihuacán, the “City of the Gods.” Walk along the majestic Avenue of the Dead, marvel at the Pyramid of the Sun and the Pyramid of the Moon and uncover the mysteries surrounding this ancient pre-Hispanic metropolis. Accompanied by an expert guide, you will learn about the legends, architecture, astronomy, and cultural aspects that make Teotihuacán a one-of-a-kind destination. Afterward, continue by visiting the Basilica of Guadalupe, one of the most visited religious sites in the world. Explore its esplanades, admire the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe, and learn about the history, tradition, and symbolism that have shaped Mexican faith for centuries. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, Lunch Buffet at Gran Teocalli Restaurant (drinks during lunch are not included), visit to the basilica of Guadalupe, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Royal Reforma 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 05

Mexico City → Heritage and Art Exploration: Coyoacán and the Frida Kahlo Museum.

Breakfast at Hotel. Your first stop will be Coyoacán, whose name in Náhuatl means “place of coyotes.” Here, your guide will provide an introduction to the origins and cultural significance of this historic district and its surroundings. You will then have time to stroll through its charming streets. Next, you will visit the Frida Kahlo Museum, also known as the “Blue House,” where you will gain insight into the profound connection between Frida, her artwork, and her home. Explore her pieces and learn about the place where she was born and where she eventually passed away. Although she lived in various locations throughout Mexico City and abroad after marrying Diego Rivera, she always returned to her beloved home in Coyoacán. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 3 Course Lunch in a Local Restaurant (drinks during lunch are not included), visit to Coyoacan and Frida Kahlo Museum, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Royal Reforma 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 06

Mexico City → Morelia Michoacan (304 km).

Breakfast at Hotel. Check Out from Mexico City Hotel. Private Transportation from Mexico City to Morelia Michoacan (304 km - 5 Hours approximately). Included: Private Transportation, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Turotel Morelia 3.5* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 07

Morelia Michoacan City Tour.

Breakfast at Hotel. We will visit the iconic city of Morelia, designate a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site and recognize as one of the most remarkable gems of colonial architecture in Mexico. Throughout our tour, we will admire the grandeur of its impressive Cathedral, one of the city's most emblematic landmarks, along with the historic Government Palace and the Plaza de los Mártires, both rich in cultural and political significance. Our journey will also take us to the traditional Candy Market, where we will experience the region's culinary heritage and enjoy handcrafted local sweets. Additionally, we will marvel at the city's famous aqueduct, one of Morelia's most recognizable structures, and the magnificent Chapel of Guadalupe, considered one of the most outstanding Baroque masterpieces in the region. Each of these locations highlights the historical and artistic richness that makes Morelia a truly exceptional destination. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person, 3 Course Lunch in a Local Restaurant (drinks during lunch are not included), Accommodation at Turotel Morelia 3.5* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 08

Morelia Michoacan → Guadalajara (289 km)

Breakfast at Hotel. Check Out from Morelia Hotel. We will continue our journey toward the city of Guadalajara, making a scheduled stop in Pátzcuaro, a distinguished "Pueblo Mágico" renowned for its rich historical, cultural, and architectural heritage. In this charming town, we will visit the iconic House of the Eleven Patios, a cultural landmark that preserves important local artisan traditions; the Basilica of Our Lady of Health, one of the most revered religious sites in the region; and the Don Vasco de Quiroga Square, considered the heart of Purépecha social and cultural life. Each of these locations showcases the deep-rooted identity and ancestral legacy that define this community. We will then resume our route to the famous Vicente Fernández Ranch, Los Tres Potrillos, entering only in accordance with the guidelines and restrictions set by the security personnel, as it is private property. During this visit, guests may enjoy the ranch's well-known restaurant—where they will have free time to purchase lunch on their own—and explore its renowned store, considered the largest Western-style shop in the world, featuring high-quality items that celebrate Mexico's charro tradition. Finally, we will continue toward the city of Guadalajara, widely recognized as "The Pearl of the West" for its remarkable architectural beauty, vibrant cultural scene, and significant historical legacy. This major cultural capital will welcome us with the warmth and authenticity that distinguish it. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Guadalajara Country Club by HNF 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 09

Guadalajara → Guadalajara City Tour.

Breakfast at Hotel. We will visit the Historic Center of Guadalajara, an iconic area that preserves centuries of history and stands as one of the most remarkable architectural and cultural ensembles in Mexico. This experience is the perfect opportunity to immerse yourself in the true essence of Guadalajara, exploring its most

representative buildings, plazas, and monuments while uncovering the traditions that shape its identity. Throughout the tour, we will bring to life the stories, anecdotes, and legends that have defined the city—ranging from the wars and social challenges that forged the capital of Jalisco, to the influential figures whose legacy continues to inspire its cultural spirit. Our journey will begin in the heart of the city, where we will visit prominent landmarks such as the imposing Metropolitan Cathedral, an unmistakable symbol of Guadalajara; the Government Palace, known for its remarkable historic murals; and the emblematic Cross of Plazas, a unique urban design that frames the historic core. We will then continue to the majestic Degollado Theater, celebrated for its impressive neoclassical architecture, followed by a visit to Fundadores Square and the expansive Plaza Tapatía, which will lead us to the extraordinary Instituto Cultural Cabañas. Designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this masterpiece stands as one of the most significant architectural and artistic institutions in Latin America. Each of these landmarks will allow us to appreciate the historical, artistic, and cultural richness that makes Guadalajara one of the most vibrant cities in the country. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Guadalajara Country Club by HNF 4* – Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 10

Guadalajara → Tequila & Tlaquepaque.

Breakfast at Hotel. We will travel to the town of Tequila, a designated “Pueblo Mágico” and the birthplace of Mexico’s most iconic spirit. In this renowned destination, we will visit a traditional distillery to learn, in detail, about each stage of the tequila-making process. From the cultivation and harvesting of the blue agave tequilana Weber to its cooking, fermentation, distillation, and the precise care required during aging, we will gain a comprehensive understanding of how this beverage has become a cultural symbol recognized worldwide. We will then continue our journey to San Pedro Tlaquepaque, a charming town that today forms part of Guadalajara’s metropolitan area. This traditional district is celebrated for its artistic atmosphere, its craftsmanship in blown glass, and its exceptional variety of Mexican handicrafts. During our visit, you will have the opportunity to admire unique pieces created by master artisans, ranging from ceramics and sculpture to textiles and high-quality decorative art. At the end of our tour, we will return to the city of Guadalajara, concluding an enriching experience filled with culture, tradition, and a deeper connection to the heritage of western Mexico. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, Private Visit to Mundo Cuervo, Tequila Tasting (4 Glasses – Jose Cuervo Tradicional brand), 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Guadalajara Country Club by HNF 4* – Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 11

Guadalajara → Guanajuato → San Miguel de Allende (340 km).

Breakfast at Hotel. Check Out from Guadalajara Hotel. We will begin our journey toward the city of Guanajuato, designated as an UNESCO World Heritage Site and home to the renowned International Cervantino Festival, one of the most important cultural events in Latin America, held annually. Upon arrival, we will enjoy a panoramic tour of this beautiful city, celebrated for its colonial layout, narrow alleyways, and charming plazas

that reflect centuries of history. Throughout the tour, we will admire several of Guanajuato's most notable landmarks, including the impressive University of Guanajuato, whose main building stands as an architectural and academic icon; the majestic Juárez Theater, regarded as one of the most significant theatrical venues in the country; and the famous Callejón del Beso (Alley of the Kiss), internationally known for the romantic legend that surrounds it. We will also visit the Diego Rivera House-Museum, the birthplace of the acclaimed Mexican muralist and husband of Frida Kahlo, which today showcases an important collection related to his life and artistic legacy. In addition, we will explore the city's unique underground streets and roadways, a distinctive feature of Guanajuato and the only system of its kind in Mexico. By mid-afternoon, we will continue our journey toward San Miguel de Allende, where we will proceed with this culturally rich and memorable experience. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Real de Minas San Miguel de Allende 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 12

San Miguel de Allende → San Miguel de Allende City Tour.

Breakfast at Hotel. We will begin our tour through this peaceful and charming city, renowned not only for its artistic and cultural atmosphere but also as the birthplace of the celebrated comedian Mario Moreno "Cantinflas," one of the most iconic figures in Mexican cinema. Over the years, San Miguel de Allende has become a haven for distinguished artists, intellectuals, and creators who have found inspiration in its urban landscapes and cosmopolitan ambiance. During our visit, we will explore several of the city's most notable historical and architectural landmarks, including the impressive Parroquia de San Miguel Arcángel, an unmistakable symbol of the city known for its striking neo-Gothic design; the Chapel of the Holy House, a site of significant religious value; the historic Convent of La Concepción, admired for its graceful colonial architecture; the Church of San Francisco, one of the region's finest examples of Baroque design; and the Allende House and Institute, an important cultural and artistic center. Visitors will also have the opportunity to enjoy a wide selection of cafés and restaurants, as well as stroll through the city's charming cobblestone streets, plazas, and scenic corners that embody the traditional and welcoming spirit of this UNESCO World Heritage city. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Real de Minas San Miguel de Allende 4* - Standard Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 13

San Miguel de Allende → Queretaro → Mexico City Airport

Breakfast at Hotel. Check Out from San Miguel de Allende Hotel. Transportation to Mexico City Airport for your departure flight - on the way stop at Queretaro. We will depart from San Miguel de Allende and continue our journey toward Querétaro, a distinguished UNESCO World Heritage City renowned for its exceptional historical, architectural, and cultural legacy. Upon arrival, we will begin a comprehensive visit to some of its most iconic landmarks, starting with the impressive Querétaro Aqueduct, one of the most remarkable examples of colonial engineering in Mexico and an unmistakable symbol of the city. Our tour will proceed to the Ex-Convent of La

Cruz, a site of great historical and religious significance that preserves important architectural elements from the colonial period. We will then explore the Historic Center, celebrated for its well-preserved urban layout and its remarkable collection of Baroque monuments. Within this area, we will visit the emblematic Plaza de la Corregidora, closely associated with Mexico’s independence movement, as well as the historic Teatro de la República, where several pivotal events in the nation’s political development took place. At the end of our visit to Querétaro, we will continue to the Mexico City International Airport, where you will board your flight to Los Cabos, marking the next stage of your journey to one of the country’s most prestigious tourist destinations. Included: Private Transportation, Entrance fees, Professional English-Speaking Guide, 2 bottles of water per person. End of Service in Mexico City Airport.
