DAY 01

MEXICO CITY → QUERETARO → SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

Private transfer from Mexico City to San Miguel de Allende on the way we will stop at Queretaro. Since 1996, the Historic Center of Queretaro has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site, thanks to the beauty of its well-preserved colonial heritage and the historical value of its buildings. If you walk through its cobblestone streets and small walkways you will find squares, museums, hotels, restaurants, bars, theaters and all kinds of attractions that you will not finish in a single visit. Inclusions: Private transportation, English speaking guide, 4 Hours Queretaro City Tour, 2 bottles of water per person. Accommodation at Real de Minas San Miguel de Allende 4* - Standard King or Twin Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 02

SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

Breakfast at hotel. On the San Miguel de Allende City Tour, you will explore one of Mexico's most iconic colonial cities, named the World's Best City in 2017. In San Miguel de Allende, Guanajuato, you will learn about Mexico's independence and visit landmarks such as the Parish of San Miguel Arcángel, the San Francisco Church, and the main square. You will also have time to sample local cuisine, shop for Mexican handicrafts, and take memorable photos. The experience also includes a visit to the famous Callejón del Beso (Alley of the Kiss), one of Guanajuato's most beloved landmarks, and an opportunity to admire the city's unique network of underground tunnels. OAXACA

Breakfast at hotel. Discover the soul of Oaxaca on an inspiring city tour that brings to life its rich history, vibrant traditions, and timeless beauty. A highlight of the tour is the Ethnobotanical Garden, a serene space showcasing the extraordinary biodiversity of the region. The experience continues with a visit to the bustling Benito Juárez or 20 de Noviembre Market, where the aromas of chocolate, spices, fresh bread, and Oaxacan cuisine create an unforgettable sensory journey. This is the perfect moment to experience the flavors that define the region's gastronomic prestige. Throughout the tour, your guide shares stories, legends, and insights that deepen your connection with this cultural capital. Whether you are drawn by its architecture, its cuisine, its artistry, or its history, Oaxaca reveals itself as a place of authenticity and heart. DAY 07

OAXACA

Breakfast at hotel. Step into the heart of Oaxaca's ancient history with a guided tour of Monte Albán, one of the most impressive archaeological sites in the Americas and a UNESCO World Heritage treasure. Perched high atop a mountain ridge with panoramic views of the valleys below, Monte Albán invites travelers to explore a civilization that flourished for more than 1,500 years. This immersive tour is designed for culturally curious travelers who seek a deeper understanding of Mexico's indigenous heritage, architecture, and enduring legacy. Your experience begins with a scenic ascent from Oaxaca City to the mountaintop plateau where Monte Albán was strategically built. Upon arrival, the sheer scale and commanding location of the site immediately evoke a sense of wonder. Once the political, cultural, and ceremonial center of the Zapotec civilization, Monte Albán stands as a testament to extraordinary engineering and urban planning. Each corner of the site holds clues to a sophisticated society that excelled in astronomy, architecture, governance, and trade. Inclusions: Private transportation, English Speaking guide, entrance fee to Monte Alban, and 2 bottle of water. Accommodation at Grand Fiesta Americana Oaxaca 5* - Standard King or Twin Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 08

OAXACA

Breakfast at hotel. Morning visit to Mitla. About 27 miles (46 km) southeast of Oaxaca, you'll find the ruins of Mitla, just outside the town of San Pablo Villa de Mitla. The ruins are of Zapotec and Mixtec origin, and the architecture here is Mixtec: quadrangle buildings surrounded by patios and chambers and very low roofs. Mitla was a religious center, run almost entirely by priests who spent most of their time undertaking human sacrifices; often by removing a live heart from the person being sacrificed, and depositing it in a pit of fire as an offering to the gods. We will continue visiting the Tule Tree, Mexico's most famous tree. El Árbol del Tule has the largest trunk diameter of any tree in Mexico, measuring almost 145 feet in circumference. It stands at over 130 feet tall, with a crown circumference of 190 feet, a volume of 28,846,044 cubic feet, and it weighs 636

tons. According to locals, it takes about 30 people holding hands to encircle the tree; talk about inspiring sights! Inclusions: Private Transportation, English speaking guide, Entrance Fee to Mitla, visit the Tule Tree and 3 bottle of water. Accommodation at Grand Fiesta Americana Oaxaca 5* - Standard King or Twin Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 09

OAXACA → MAZUNTE

Breakfast at hotel. Check out from Grand Fiesta Americana Oaxaca Hotel and private transfer to Mazunte Hotel. Accommodation at Casa Lú Mazunte Hotel Boutique - Adults Only 4* - Suite Deluxe King or Twin Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 10

MAZUNTE

Breakfast at hotel. Day at Leisure. Accommodation at Casa Lú Mazunte Hotel Boutique - Adults Only 4* - Suite Deluxe King or Twin Room - Bed and Breakfast.

DAY 11

MAZUNTE → OAXACA

Breakfast at hotel. At the proper time private transfer to Oaxaca airport for your departure flight (Flight not included).
