### 02 / DAY BY DAY

## Itinerary

#### DAY 01

### **(Thursday): Zagreb**

Arrival at Zagreb Airport and transfer to the hotel. The rest of the day is free.

#### DAY 02

### **(Friday): Zagreb - Plitvice Lakes - Split**

After breakfast, departure to Plitvice National Park, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Continue to Split. Arrival and accommodation at the hotel.

#### DAY 03

### **(Saturday): Šibenik - Split**

Breakfast. Guided city tour including a visit to the Cathedral of St. James. Free time for lunch and transfer to Split to board the cruise. The ship will be docked at the port of Split, and boarding will be possible from 14:00. Overnight in Split.

#### DAY 04

### **(Sunday): Split - Trogir**

In the morning, our Spanish-speaking guide will take you on a guided tour of the city of Split, visiting the world-famous Diocletian's Palace. Afterwards, you will have the afternoon free to explore on your own or dine in one of the cozy taverns of Trogir. Overnight in the historic center of Trogir.

#### DAY 05

### **Trogir to Vis via Bol: Adriatic Island Sailing**

In the morning we will sail toward Bol. After lunch, we will continue sailing to the island of Vis, which used to be an important strategic military base and was Therefore, it is protected from mass tourism development. Enjoy the afternoon exploring the town of Vis.

#### DAY 06

### **(Tuesday): Vis - Blue Cave of Biševo - Hvar**

We will sail to the island of Biševo and its Blue Cave, one of the most famous natural attractions in the entire Adriatic Sea. After a swimming stop and lunch on board, we will continue sailing to Hvar, the sunniest island in

Croatia. Upon arrival, a Spanish-speaking local guide will accompany you on a tour of this unique town, presenting its thousand-year history, culture, and lifestyle. Overnight in the historic center of Hvar.

#### DAY 07

### **(Wednesday): Hvar - Korčula**

Departure in the morning to the island of Korčula. Arrival is expected in the afternoon. Our Spanish-speaking guide will accompany you on a city tour of Korčula, walking through its narrow cobblestone streets and discovering its rich history. The rest of the afternoon will be free to enjoy dinner at one of the local restaurants of your choice. Overnight in the historic center of Korčula.

#### DAY 08

### **(Thursday): Korčula - Mljet National Park - Slano**

Sailing to Mljet National Park. You will have enough time to explore the park. In the afternoon, we will continue sailing to Slano, located on the mainland. In the evening, we will celebrate the Captain's Dinner on board, accompanied by live music.

#### DAY 09

### **(Friday): Slano - Dubrovnik**

Morning departure to Dubrovnik. We will disembark directly in the Old Town, where our Spanish-speaking guide will show you the most interesting sites of Dubrovnik. Free time to explore the city on your own. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

#### DAY 10

### **(Saturday): Dubrovnik - Athens**

Private transfer from the port to Dubrovnik Airport. Arrival at Athens Airport, assistance, and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

#### DAY 11

### **(Sunday): Athens**

Breakfast and departure for a city tour of Athens: Panathenaic Stadium (Kalimarmaro), Hadrian's Arch, Parliament and the Monument to the Unknown Soldiers with the traditional Changing of the Guard at Constitution Square (Syntagma Square), and Omonia Square. Visit to the Acropolis: the Propylaea, the Ionic Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion, the Parthenon, and the New Acropolis Museum. Free afternoon and

overnight stay.

#### DAY 12

### **(Monday): Delphi - Meteora**

Breakfast and departure for an excursion to Delphi, where you will visit the Delphi Archaeological Museum and the archaeological site. Continue to Kalambaka. Arrival at the hotel, dinner, and overnight stay.

#### DAY 13

### **(Tuesday): Meteora - Athens**

Departure to Meteora to visit the monasteries perched on the rocks—an unforgettable sight. Continue to Thermopylae and arrive in Athens around 18:00. Overnight stay.

#### DAY 14

### **(Wednesday): Athens**
