Itinerary

DAY 01

ARRIVAL IN MADRID

Arrival in Madrid, meeting with our driver and transfer to the hotel. Free time. Accommodation.

DAY 02

MADRID - TOLEDO - MADRID

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Toledo (meeting point provided by the agency). Arrival in Toledo and visit outside the Cathedral; Church of Sao Tome and Synagogue of Santa Maria la Blanca. We will finish the tour with a demonstration of the famous damasquinadotechnology (inlay of precious metals in steel) After the visit and return to Madrid. Free time. Accommodation.

DAY 03

MADRID - SEVILLA

Breakfast at the hotel and at the agreed time transfer to the station to take the AVE towards Seville. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Free time. Accommodation.

DAY 04

SEVILLA

Breakfast and visit of the city (meeting point provided by the agency). Visit the most representative monuments of Seville in a single tour. We will leave on a regular minibus tour to discover the most important monuments of the city, such as the University, the Old Tobacco Factory, the Spanish Steps, the most emblematic work of the Ibero-American Exhibition of 1929, the Palace of San Telmo, the Torre del Oro and the Bridge of Isabel II. Then we will discover the Barrio de Santa Cruz, Antigua Judería in a maze formed by narrow streets in the famous Plaza de los Venerables. We will start our visit by the Royal Alcazars, the Royal Palace and the Cathedral of Seville. End of visit at the Cathedral. In the afternoon, cruise the Guadalquivir to admire some monuments from another very interesting point of view. Accommodation

DAY 05

SEVILLA -GRANADA -SEVILLA

Breakfast at the hotel and at the agreed time departure to Granada for a day tour city on a regular tour visiting the Alhambra, the Palace and the Generalife, one of the most visited monuments in Spain. Pick-up and drop-off

Hotel. Lunch not included. After the visit, We will return to Seville. Accommodation.

DAY 06

SEVILLA-MARRAKECH

Breakfast at the hotel and at the agreed time transfer to Seville airport to take flight to Marrakech. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Accommodation.

DAY 07

MARRAKECH -AITBEHADDOU -OUARZAZATE

Breakfast at the hotel and departure towards Ouarzazate crossing Tizi'n Tichka, mountain located at 2,260 meters of altitude; during the trip, visit the best point of the trip, the Kasbah "Ait Ben Haddou" UNESCO World Heritage Site and then visit the Kasbah of Taourit, in other times residence of the Marrakesh pacha and the film studios where some of the most famous films were shot as "The Mummy", "Gladiator", "Prince of Persia". Continue to Ouarzazate. Check-in, dinner and Accommodation.

DAY 08

OUARZAZATE -AGDZ-MERZOUGA

Breakfast at the hotel and departure towards Agdez through the neck of Tizi-n-Tinifit crossing the Draa valley and Ksour where we can observe its entourage of palm groves, we will pass through Erfoud and Risani to finally reach Merzouga.

Dinner and accommodation in the Bedouin camp of Haima. Possibility of walking in dromedary to appreciate the sunset or sunrise from the golden sand dunes.

DAY 09

MERZOUGA -RISSANI-ERFOUD-TINJDAD-TINGHIR-DADES

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Tineghir to visit this great Oasis and its spectacular natural gorges of Todra. We will pass through the ancient capital of Rissani, Tafilalet. In Rissani was established one of the main shopping centers of the region, we will continue towards Erfoud. Erfoud is a new city founded in 1913 by the French.

We'll continue to the Dades' throats. Dinner and accommodation.

DAY 10

DADES-KALAATMEGOUNA -SKOURA-MARRAKECH

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to Marrakech passing through Boumalne, known as the Valley of roses. This valley is located at the foot of the High Atlas in Morocco and Skoura. Is one of the few forests in the country that still remains inhabited. There are approximately 30,138 palm trees and the one that inhabits it is Arabic. We will continue our tour to Marrakech through Ouarzazate.

Check in and accommodation.

DAY 11

MARRAKECH

Breakfast at the hotel and departure to visit the most beautiful of the imperial cities of Morocco. We will discover the streets of the Medina, the authentic heart of the city that is formed by a maze of narrow streets that will surprise us on every corner.

We will enjoy its unique mix of colors and sensations with its red walls shadow of its millennial palm grove. We will discover its fascinating past through its ancient monuments: Menara Gardens, Koutoubia Minarete, Tombs Saadian... Accommodation

DAY 12

MARRAKECH -LISBON

Breakfast at the hotel and airport transfer to Lisbon. Arrival in Lisbon and transfer to the Hotel.

Free time and accommodation.

DAY 13

LISBON

Breakfast at the hotel and WE will start of the city visit (meeting point facilitated by agency). We will take a walking tour of Rossio Square, the heart of the old and modern Lisbon. Next, we'll look at the Restaurateur Square, where a obelisk commemorates Portugal's independence from Spain in 1640.

From here, you can admire Avenida Liberdade, the Eden Theatre (one of the best examples of Portuguese Art Deco) and the Palace of Foz, eighteenth century. Then walk through the Elegant District of Chiado, full of old cafes, boutiques, theaters and bookstores. Discover this aristocratic neighborhood, one of the most interesting pedestrian areas of Lisbon. Continue to the Alfama district, Lisbon's oldest district. This neighborhood is the Fado cradle, Portugal's characteristic

musical genre. Find out more about this kind of music at the Fado Museum and some of the hidden Fado restaurants in the Area. Here will end our visit and we will enjoy a delicious Portuguese dinner accompanied by a Fados show. Return to the hotel on your own. Accommodation

DAY 14

LISBON-FATIMA-OBIDOS-LISBON

Breakfast at the hotel and full-day tour. (regular tour, meeting point provided by the agency) Today we will go north of Lisbon on a full-day trip to a bygone era, where small towns offer a relaxing walk and historical religious monuments dot the landscape. Its first stop is Óbidos, a fortified village with whitewashed houses and narrow streets with an unmistakable atmosphere Medieval. Enjoy the free time to stroll through cobbled alleys and alleys full of colorful Gothic houses and arches. Relax in a coffee shop or try the liquor Ginja in one of the many wine shops. Then continue to Alcobaca to visit the famous Monastery of Santa Maria d'Alcobaca, a declared place UNESCO World Heritage Site, and Portugal's largest Gothic church.

Our last visit will be Fatima, once a quiet rural village that became an important place of pilgrimage in 1917 when three small shepherds reported that there had been apparitions of the Virgin Mary, also known as Our Lady of Fatima (Nossa Senhora de Fatima). Here you will have free time to visit the Sanctuary of Fatima, a basilica that honors the apparition and attracts millions of Catholic pilgrims each year to pay their respects to the sanctuary.

DAY 15

LISBON-PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel and at the agreed time transfer to the train station to take the train towards Porto. Arrival and transfer to the hotel. Free time. Accommodation.

DAY 16

PORTO

Breakfast at the hotel and half-day tour on regular tour. (Meeting point facilitated by the agency) Porto is the capital of northern Portugal and declared a Humanity by UNESCO.

Porto has one of the most notable historical centers in Europe and was selected as the first European destination of 2013 by Lonely Planet.

During our cultural tour we will have the opportunity to discover interesting places such as the Bolhao Market, Santa Catarina Street, the Majestic Café, Aliados Avenue, the Cathedral, Batalha Square, Infante D. Henrique Square and many other wonderful places. Afternoon free to continue enjoying this beautiful city on your own.
