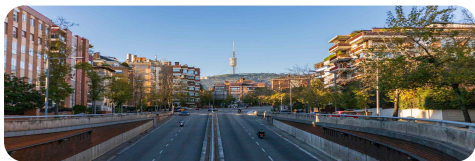

Itinerary

DAY 01

ARRIVAL IN BARCELONA

Arrival at Barcelona airport and then you can pick up the rental car at the terminal and drive to the hotel. In the afternoon, we recommend visiting the city through the most important avenues, squares and buildings, walking along its famous Ramblas, Gothic Quarter, Plaza Catalunya . Accommodation.

DAY 02

BARCELONA

Breakfast at the hotel time to explore the city. Barcelona combines history and traditions with the latest culinary, cultural and artistic trends. We propose you to take a walk that begins in historical places of visit such as Via Laietana, the Cathedral and its cloister, the Gothic Quarter and Placa St. Jaume. After this immersion in traditional Barcelona, we would like to show you another side of the city. With the celebration of the Olympic Games in Barcelona, the coastline was inaugurated and strengthened economically and socially. And what better way to immerse ourselves in the era of change by visiting the Olympic port, then go up to Montjuic to visit the Olympic Stadium of Lluís Companys, the Palau St. Jordi and the Torre Calatrava. Finally, we will visit the Poble Espanyol, a selection of typical buildings from all over Spain. To continue discovering the city, we propose the other interesting part of the city. Barcelona is known as the capital of modernism, where the famous architect Antonio Gaudí lived and worked. We will contemplate his most emblematic works such as Casa Milá, also known as 'La Pedrera', and Casa Batlló on our tour of the Passeig de Gracia. Then we will visit the Park Guell, a large garden in which the genius insisted on a perfect integration of the architectural elements into nature and was declared a cultural monument and world heritage site by UNESCO. Don't forget to visit the Sagrada Familia atoning church, a masterpiece that Gaudí left unfinished and is still built in the same way as cathedrals in the Middle Ages, with donations and special contributions. Finally, we will visit st.Maria del Mar, the only great Catalan Gothic church perfectly finished. Accommodation in the hotel.

DAY 03

BARCELONA - VALENCIA (349 km)

Have breakfast at the hotel and head to Valencia. On arrival and the rest of the day you have a lot free time to explore the city of Valencia: we advise you, Plaza de la Reina, Cathedral (outside), Plaza de la Virgen, Plaza

Redonda, Plaza del Patriarca, facade of the Palacio del Marqués de Dos Aguas, Plaza del Ayuntamiento, market and Central Market. We don't forget the impressive City of Arts and Sciences. Accommodation

DAY 04

VALENCIA - GRANADA (498 km)

Breakfast and day trip to Andalusia. After arriving, registration and Accommodation in the hotel.

DAY 05

GRANADA - SEVILLA (248 km)

Breakfast at the hotel and then you will have free time to discover Granada. Is recommended visiting the Alhambra and the Generalife, whose construction was initiated by the founder of the Nasrid dynasty Mohammed Ibn Alhamar in the 13th century on the hill overlooking Granada. First he made the Alcazaba and then the Royal Palace and the high Medina or Alhambra, residence of the courtiers. Departure to Seville. Arrival and Hotel accommodation.

DAY 06

SEVILLA

After breakfast at the hotel, there will be a whole day to explore this beautiful City. During your trip you will find the beauty of monuments such as the University of Seville, Triana and the monastery of the Bridge of the Carthusian. Get to the wall built under Julius Caesar's empire and visit the Basilica of the Macarena, the beautiful Virgin of Seville. Don't forget to discover the Santa Cruz neighborhood, where our senses are still fascinated by the beauty of its streets, courtyards and flowers. Seville Cathedral, the most world, where you can also enjoy spectacular views of the city from which today is perhaps the symbol of the capital of Andalusia, the Giralda. We recommend at night to know any of the "Tablaos Flamencos" to enjoy Spanish music and dance. Accommodation.

DAY 07

SEVILLA - CORDOBA (140 km)

Breakfast at the hotel. We recommend that you go to Cordoba early in the day to explore the city, stroll through the Jewish Quarter and visit its impressive mosque / Cathedral. Accommodation.

DAY 08

CORDOBA - TOLEDO (345 km) - MADRID (70 km)

After breakfast, heading to Toledo, one of the most beautiful cities in Spain, located 70 kilometers from Madrid. Here we recommend that you make a stop for walk and see the city, strolling through the Town Hall Square and then you can see the facade of the primate Cathedral of extravagant Gothic style, the old palace of justice and the Town Hall; We will walk through the narrow streets of the old Jewish quarter to enter the Church of Sao Tome and admire the monumental painting "The Burial of the Count Orgaz", the most outstanding work of El Greco; we continue towards the Synagogue of Santa Maria la Blanca, witness to the merger of "Three Cultures", the monastery of San Juan of the Kings and the Victorio Macho Museum, with beautiful views over the Tagus River. Continuation to Madrid and Accommodation.

DAY 09

MADRID

After breakfast at the hotel you will have a full day in the city to get to know the most important corners: Plaza Mayor, Puerta del Sol, Palacio Real, Gran Vía, Plaza de Toros de las Ventas . Accommodation.

DAY 10

MADRID AND RETURN

Breakfast and departure to the airport. After returning the car and registering your flight, it would be the end of the trip and our services.
