Itinerary

DAY 01

ARRIVAL IN LEON

Arrival in Leon. In this nice city you can visit emblematic places such as the Cathedral of León, the Wet Quarter (tapas area), the Plaza Mayor, the Collegiate Church of San Isidoro or the Museum of Contemporary Art of Castile and León. Accommodation

DAY 02

LEON-RABANAL DEL CAMINO (69 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. They will start the French Way from León, with a cycling stage to Rabanaldel Camino. They will cross the municipalities of Villadangosdel Páramo and Astorga. In the first town you can visit the Church of St. James the Apostle and Astorga will be able to contemplate both the Cathedral and the Episcopal Palace, as well as the Roman legacy maintained by this city. You can also taste the local cuisine and especially the famous Maragato stew. Accommodation.

DAY 03

RABANAL DEL CAMINO -VILLAFRANCA DEL VIERZO (55.7 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. The stage corresponding to this day will be from Rabanaldel Camino to Villafranca del Bierzo. In this you will pass through the village of Molinaseca, a reference point on the Camino with tourist attractions such as the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Anguish, the Church of St. Nicholas of Bari, the Pilgrims' Bridge or the Cruceiro de Holy Christ. Once in Villafranca, you can visit the church of Santiago. The Announced, Saint Nicholas, the Collegiate, El Castillo, La Alameda, the Plaza Mayor and many other places. Accommodation.

DAY 04

VILLAFRANCA DEL BIERZO -TRIACASTELA (55, 6 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. From Villafranca del Bierzo they will depart for Triacastela, passing through O Cebreiro. In the latter you will find the Church of Santa María la Real del Cebreiro, in pre-Romanesque style, as well as the Ethnographic Museum of O Cebreiro. In Triacastela may visit a Church of the 11th century, as well as other temples that are also located in this municipality. Accommodation

DAY 05

TRIACASTELA-PALAS DE REI (70 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. Leaving Triacastela, the new stage will take you to Palas de Rei. On the way to Palas, you'll be able to see the Sarria and Portomarín. Sarria is the point chosen by many pilgrims to start the journey

and has interesting places to visit, such as the Parish Church of Santa Mariña, the Church of the Savior and the Convent of the Magdalene. In Portomarín, which is located next to the river Minho, you will find the chapel of the Virgin of the Snows, the Church-fortress of San Nicolás, the church of San Pedro and the pazos of Conde da Maza and dos Pimentales. Finally, Palas de Rei, has a full-sum count artistic wealth as well demonstrated by the churches of San Tirso, Pambre Castle and the Pazo de Ulloa. Accommodation

DAY 06

PALAS DE REI-SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (69 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. Ready for the last stage, this time they will depart from Palas de Rei bound for Santiago. Along the way, both Arzúa and O Pedrouzo will be the two main points before reaching Santiago. In Arzúa, the former Convent of the Magdalene and the parish church of Santiago. In O Pedrouzo, belonging to the concello of O Pino, the hermitage of Santa Irene. Already in this beautiful city, you will be offered endless places to visit. The main attraction is the Cathedral and the Plaza del Obradoiro, but it is not the only interest since it is also advisable to take a walk through the old town, taste the offer visit other emblematic buildings such as the hostal de los Reyes Católicos and the Monastery of San Martín Pinario. Accommodation
