Itinerary

DAY 01

ARRIVAL IN TUI

Upon arrival in Tui, you can enjoy the charms offered by this municipality bordering Portugal. Some of the most noteworthy tourist attractions are the International Bridge over the Minho River, the remains that are preserved from the Wall (S. XII), Porta da Pla, the Cathedral of Santa Maria and the Diocesan Museum, the chapel of San Telmo and the Convent of the Clares. On the outskirts of Tui you can visit the Gothic church of Santo Domingo. Accommodation

DAY 02

TUI-O PORRIÑO 2. (18.7 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. We will start our route to O Porriño. Once you arrive in this town, you will be able to know the Building of the Town Hall, the Botica Nova, La Fuente del Cristo and the Temple of San Luis. We also recommend you to taste the bread of O Porriño, famous for its flavor and taste. Accommodation

DAY 03

O PORRIÑO-REDONDELA (15.2 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. Arriving at Redondela, located at the end of the Vigo Estuary, you will find a Roman military of the XIX. This is only one way to welcome the pilgrim to the village, as through its streets you will find even more places worth knowing: the pilgrim hostel, the Santa Teresa house, the convent of Vilavella or the Church of Santiago. In addition, it also you can take a pleasant walk through the Alameda Park. Accommodation

DAY 04

REDONDELA-PONTEVEDRA (15.5 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. On this day they will finally arrive in the first city of the Portuguese Way in Spain. In the historic center of Pontevedra you can visit the Shrine of the Virgin Pilgrim. Passing the Porta do Camiño, you will enter the Plaza de Ferrería, area of terraces and bars, but where the Convent of San Francisco is also located. Nearby are the Plaza de la Estrella, the House of faces, the gardens of Castro Sampedro and the Provincial Museum. Accommodation

DAY 05

PONTEVEDRA-CALDAS DE REIS (21.5 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. In addition to being the birthplace of King Alfonso VII of León, Caldas is a point of relaxation, its therapeutic hot springs are known. You can also take a walk around the village and visit places such as St. Mary's Church and St. Thomas Becket Church, or the Botanical Garden. Accommodation

DAY 06

CALDAS DE REIS-PADRON (19.5 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. Padrón is known as the village where he landed the lifeless body of the Apostle Santiago in the year 44. Among the places to visit are the church of Santiago, the bridge of Santiago, the fountain of Carmen, the Convent of Carmen and the Casa A Matanza (the museum house of Rosalía de Castro). Padrón peppers are also famous in this area, a delicious variety said to be chopped and some not. Accommodation

DAY 07

PADRON-SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (24.3 kms)

Breakfast at the hotel. Ready for the last stage, this time they will depart from O Predrouzo bound for Santiago. Already in this beautiful city, you will be offered endless places to visit. The main attraction is the Cathedral and the Plaza del Obradoiro, but it is not the only interest since it is also advisable to take a walk in the old town, taste the culinary offer and visit other emblematic buildings such as the Hostal de los Reyes Católicos and the Monastery of San Martín Pinario. Accommodation
